Objectives:

- To provide a forum for discussion of statistical, data management, research computing, regulatory, philosophical, ethical, and procedural and management issues arising from the design, organization, operation, analysis and reporting of clinical trials.
- To promote methodological research and the application of sound scientific methods in intervention trials
- To facilitate communication among the various disciplines involved in the conduct of clinical trials
- To educate and inform health care researchers about the design, operation and analysis of clinical trials
- To promote better understanding by the general public of the importance of randomized clinical trials in evaluating interventions for the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of disease
