Mission

Challenges

Sustainability of the Society: The key to sustainability and long-term success of the Society is to attract a multidisciplinary membership by providing an attractive and recognized venue for information and debate on all aspects of clinical trial methodology and conduct.

Leadership Development within the Society: Closely tied to the goal of sustainability of the Society is the assurance of continued participation and leadership within the Society. The Society must devote sufficient time and resources to developing the next generation of Society leadership.

Financial Sustainability of the Society: An organization like SCT should strive to have enough in its financial reserves to operate for at least two years.
